OPENING OF 15 TEACHING POSITIONS AT THE NATIONAL ADVANCED SCHOOL OF PUBLIC WORKS (YAOUNDE)

In accordance with the instructions of the President of the Republic, Head of State, the Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education, informs the general public that fifteen (15) teaching positions are open at the National Advanced School of Public Works (NASPW), Yaounde for the 2024 fiscal year to persons of Cameroonian nationality, aged at most 45 years on 1st October 2024 and holders of a Doctorat or PhD.

The teaching positions shall be distributed as follows:

After the publication of the authorization to open teaching positions, the Director of NASPW shall open the said positions through a call for applications in the different fields concerned.

Each interested candidate shall submit his or her file to the NASPW no later than 28 May 2024.

Cameroonians living abroad shall submit their applications in Diplomatic Missions and Consular Offices latest on 28 May 2024.

The application file shall include the following documents:

- A stamped application not older than three (3) months, addressed to the Director of NASPW;
- 2. A certified true photocopy of the birth certificate dated less than three months;
- 3. A detailed and signed curriculum vitae;
- Certified photocopies of all diplomas obtained from the Baccalauréat or GCE Advanced Level;
- 5. A copy of the Doctorat or PhD thesis;
- 6. Copies of articles or off prints of any publications, where necessary;
- 7. A medical certificate issued within the last three (3) months by a medical doctor in the public health sector;
- 8. Four passport size photographs (colour);
- 9. A photocopy of a valid National Identity Card;
- 10. A certificate of non-conviction issued within the last three (3) months;
- 11. An attestation of service as permanent lecturer in the home university, duly signed by a competent authority for candidates for the rank of Lecturer, Associate Professor and Professor;
- A certificate of nationality and/or, for candidates living abroad, photocopies of passports and residence permits certified by the Cameroonian consular services;
- A certificate of effective presence duly signed by a competent authority (for applicants with a job);
- 14.A prior authorization from the user Minister or the Head of the home administration (for applicants with a job);
- 15. A copy of the National Disability Card (for disabled persons);
- 16. An undertaking on (i) the authenticity of the documents provided, (ii) the effective availability of the candidate and, for candidates living abroad, (iii) the non-existence of any situation likely to expose the applicant to a double salary situation.

The recruitment will respect the following process:

For candidates for the position of Assistant Lecturer:

- File review and interview of the candidate within the Teachers' Council, according to the modalities to be defined by NASPW;
- Opinion of the Teaching, Study, Research and Scientific Council of NASPW;
- Approval and publication of the final lists by the Minister in charge of Higher Education.

For candidates to the ranks of Lecturer, Associate Professor or Professor:

- Opinion of the Consultative Committee of University Institutions (CCUI);
- Approval and publication of the final lists by the Minister in charge of Higher Education.
